Health service CEO has been reappointed

Kyabram District Health Service Chief Executive, Peter Abraham, has been reappointed to serve in the role for a further three years.

Board President, Maureen Atkins, said “The Board was pleased to offer Mr Abraham a three year contract. With his background in Quality he has overseen the continuous improvement of an already strong quality system. This provides the Board confidence in the safe services provided to the community by all sections of the health service.”

Mr Abraham has been responsible for a number of capital projects including the design and building of the Health & Wellbeing Centre, redevelopment of the Radiology and Pathology service, and completion for the Sheridan Aged Care stage 4 redevelopment.
